WHAT IS BLEPHARITIS?

Blepharitis is inflammation of the edges of the eyelids. It is not infectious and can affect people of all ages. Blepharitis is not usually sight-threatening but can be troublesome since it can recur.

WHAT ARE THE TYPES OF BLEPHARITIS?

There are two types of blepharitis:

- **Anterior Blepharitis**

This affects the outside front edge of the eyelids (near and in-between your eyelashes). This is usually caused by bacteria.

- **Posterior Blepharitis**

Also called meibomian gland dysfunction (MGD). This occurs when the function of the glands, which normally provide the oily layer of your tears, is reduced.

WHO IS AT RISK OF BLEPHARITIS?

Blepharitis is more common in people over the age of 50, but it can develop at any age. It is generally a chronic condition, which means it can return even after it has cleared, so long-term treatment is usually required.



WHAT ARE THE SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF BLEPHARITIS?

- Red and inflamed eyelids
- Crusting around the eyelids
- Itching and discomfort
- Gritty sensation on the surface of the eye
- Burning sensation
- Fluctuations in vision



WHAT ARE THE TREATMENT OPTIONS FOR BLEPHARITIS?

Treatment of blepharitis depends on the severity of the disease.

The following are a few measures your doctor might advise you on. It is not an immediate cure, and it may take 4-6 weeks before treatment starts to be effective. Perseverance is essential.

Try not to rub your eyelids, as this may make inflammation worse.

WHAT IS LID EXFOLIATION?

During your consultation, you may be advised that you need a lid exfoliation treatment.

BlephEx™/NuLids is a proven treatment that effectively removes bacteria and debris that can build up on the eyelashes, causing inflammation associated with blepharitis. It can be used alongside other treatments or as a sole procedure and is more effective than using eyelid scrubs alone.

It is a painless procedure that gently unblocks the oil glands, leaving clean, clear, and comfortable eyes.

Most people notice the benefits immediately. Together with the dry eye treatment plan that our specialist will discuss with you, you should notice a marked improvement in your dry eye symptoms. Treatments are usually needed twice a year but will be adapted to suit your needs.

WHAT IS EYELID HYGIENE?

During your consultation, you may be advised that you need to carry out at home eyelid hygiene.

This can involve the use of simple wipes or more specialist products. Our team of clinical specialists will provide you with a bespoke plan as required.

ANTIBIOTIC TABLETS

Some forms of blepharitis require a course of antibiotic tablets. If they cause any side effects, stop the tablets and contact us immediately.

STEROID EYEDROPS / OINTMENTS

Occasionally, when the symptoms of blepharitis are severe, your specialist may prescribe a course of steroid drops to help control inflammation and symptoms.

ARTIFICIAL TEARS

All forms of blepharitis are associated with some degree of dryness in the eyes. Your doctor may prescribe artificial tears to help alleviate symptoms.

FLAXSEED OIL/ OMEGA CAPSULES

Flax seed oil, similar to evening primrose oil, contains omega oils to improve tear quality and help with dry eye symptoms.

Take one capsule (1000mg or 1200mg) with breakfast and another with your evening meal.

NEW INNOVATION IN DRY EYE

There are now a range of at home gadgets available to help with dry eye symptoms, your optometrist will be able to advise you on the most suitable products for your needs.

BLINK TRAINING

Research shows that our blink rate decreases and blink fullness diminishes during tasks like using a computer or reading. To encourage proper gland function, remind yourself to blink regularly. The 20-20-20 rule is a good prompt: every 20 minutes, look 20 feet away and blink for 20 seconds.



IPL TREATMENT FOR BLEPHARITIS

IPL, or intense pulsed light, is a light-based therapy applied to the surface of the skin. It has been used for years to treat conditions such as rosacea and scarring and is also used to treat ocular surface disease.

HOW DOES IPL HELP WITH DRY EYES?

Dry eye disease can be caused by abnormal blood vessels under the skin's surface that deliver inflammatory markers to the eye while affecting meibomian glands. IPL therapy destroys these abnormal blood vessels and helps restore normal gland function, reducing inflammation and improving tear production.

CAN IPL TREAT OTHER CONDITIONS?

Other than treating dry eyes, IPL can also help with rosacea, acne scarring, and general facial rejuvenation. These treatments can be performed at the same time as dry eye treatment.

WHAT IS THE IPL MACHINE USED?

At OCL, we use the latest advanced IPL system. It delivers consistent energy, reducing risks and allowing for more effective treatment.

WHAT HAPPENS ON THE DAY OF IPL TREATMENT?

Arrive without makeup or creams. A gel is applied to the treated area, eye shields will be placed on your eyes, and a test pass will be performed to determine how the skin reacts. The treatment is quick, relatively painless, and lasts around 5 minutes.

HOW MANY IPL TREATMENTS ARE NEEDED?

Typically, four to six treatments are needed, spaced 2-3 weeks apart. Maintenance treatments are recommended once or twice a year.

WHAT IS THE AFTERCARE FOR IPL?

You may experience mild sunburn-like sensations or swelling. Keep the skin moisturized with SPF 30 minimum and avoid direct sunlight for two weeks after treatment. Apply mineral makeup the next day if desired.

ZEST TREATMENT

ZEST is an innovative deep-cleaning treatment designed to remove biofilm, debris, and bacterial buildup from the eyelid margins. Unlike traditional home treatments, ZEST uses a natural okra-based gel to thoroughly cleanse the lids, improving tear film stability and reducing inflammation.


