LENS REPLACEMENT SURGERY

Following your detailed consultation and specialist tests with us at OCL Vision, we are delighted to confirm that you are suitable for Lens Replacement Surgery.

Lens replacement surgery is also known as Refractive lens exchange (RLE) and is technically identical to cataract surgery, but performed as a method of vision correction in the absence of a cataract.

The aim of the treatment is to **significantly reduce** your dependence on glasses or contact lenses or eliminate them completely.

During lens replacement surgery the natural lens protein is removed and a new customised lens implant is placed within the eye, correcting your prescription.

The lenses implanted during lens replacement surgery do not



deteriorate after implantation and because the natural lens protein is removed, there is **no possibility of developing a cataract as you age.**

Due to improvements in safety, we are now able to **treat both eyes on the same day in most patients.** In some cases it may be desirable or your preference to treat one eye at a time, usually with 1-2 weeks between eyes.

About the Surgery STANDARD LENS REPLACEMENT SURGERY

The surgery is usually carried out using local anaesthetic eye drops and takes around 10-15 minutes per eye.

There are no injections to the eye nor any stitches. It is possible to have sedation to relax you prior to your surgery if you wish. You will receive numbing drops in your eyes and **you will not feel any pain** during the procedure, just some mild pressure. An ultrasound device is used to remove the natural lens

protein before lens implantation. Clear plastic shields are placed in front of the eyes immediately following surgery to protect them until you return home. You will be able to see adequately to walk out of the operating theatre once the surgery is completed. **Recovery is rapid within the first 24-48 hours.**

LASER FINE-TUNING AFTER LENS REPLACEMENT SURGERY

Laser eye surgery allows further enhancement of the outcome of lens replacement surgery where there may be a small residual glasses prescription (1-2% of cases).

Laser enhancement is available to all lens replacement surgery patients at OCL Vision without additional cost.

WHAT TYPE OF LENSES DO YOU NEED?

The lens type that is used will depend on your visual and lifestyle needs.

Your surgeon will discuss these with you at your consultation and will **help you choose the lenses that will work best for you.** We only use advanced technology from the world's leading manufacturers.



What do I need to do to **PREPARE FOR TREATMENT?**

You will need to:

- **Sign your consent form electronically** on the surgery pack you will have received from DocuSign when you book your surgery, as well as your aftercare explanation.
- **Bring sunglasses** - they will help keep your eyes comfortable on the way home.
- **Not wear eye make up** on the day of treatment.
- **Remove contact lenses** for three days prior to surgery.
- **Organise getting home afterwards.** At OCL Vision we offer a comprehensive concierge service to cater for your transportation and accommodation needs.
- **Download our free dropAdrop reminder app** from the App Store or Google Play. The app sends you notifications to make sure you never miss a drop of your essential aftercare drops.

What happens on **THE SURGERY DAY?**

- You will be at the clinic for **three hours**. It is important to arrive early or at your designated time.
- The nurses will **prepare** you for surgery. They will use drops and a pellet to dilate your pupil(s) and **discuss the aftercare** with you.
- You will meet your surgeon again before surgery, who will explain **what to expect** during the surgery and answer any questions.
- The surgery takes approximately **10 – 20 minutes** (per eye).
- After surgery, you will **rest in the recovery suite** for 15-30 minutes. Beverages and snacks are available. During this time we will check that you are feeling well and ensure you are given any immediate post-operative medications.
- Your eyes may feel tired or gritty for the rest of the day so we advise that you **go home and rest**. Vision is functional but not fully focused for the first **12-24 hours after surgery**.
- We will give you clear **eye shields** to wear at night after surgery to protect your eyes while you sleep.
- We advise taking **1 week off work** and limiting screen time following the procedure to let your eyes fully recover.
- Please use all **post-operative drops** as instructed and follow the **dropAdrop™ app prompts**.
- Only **your chosen surgeon** will carry out the actual procedure himself/herself.

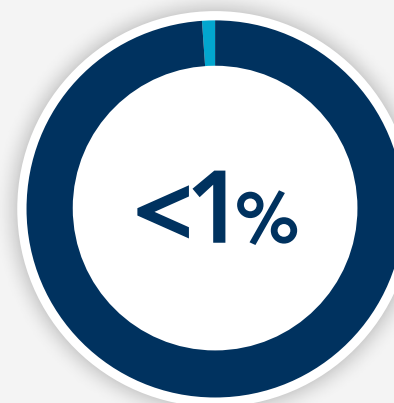
* If your eyes feel sticky, they can be bathed with cooled boiled water using cotton pads.

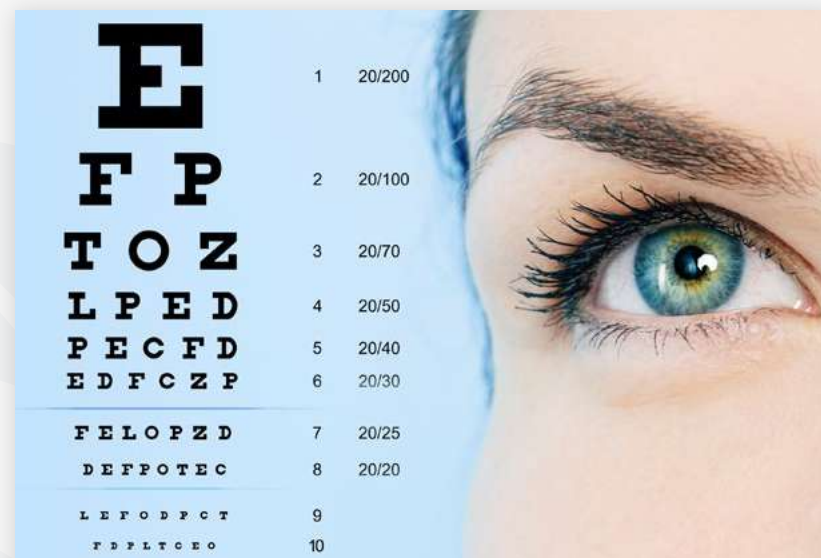
Self-Pay Patients

20/20 VISION CHART EXPLANATION

The 20/20 vision chart helps assess your visual acuity, measuring how clearly you can see letters or symbols from a distance of 20 feet.

If your vision is 20/20, you see what someone with normal vision sees at 20 feet. But if it's 20/40, you need to be 20 feet away to see what others see at 40 feet.

The chart has rows of decreasingly sized letters or symbols. Some people have sharper vision than 20/20, like 20/15 or even 20/10, **achievable with modern vision correction techniques** like laser eye surgery. For instance, if someone has 20/15 vision, they can see at 20 feet what a person with normal vision would need to be at 15 feet to see clearly.

At OCL Vision, we're here to discuss your options and guide you towards superior vision. Most of our patients experience better vision than they used to before with glasses or contacts.
