

About the Surgery CATARACT SURGERY

Following your detailed consultation and specialist tests with us at OCL Vision, we are delighted to confirm that you are suitable for cataract surgery.

When you have a cataract, the natural lens in the eye is clouded and impairs your eyesight. During cataract surgery the cloudy natural lens is removed and

replaced with a clear artificial lens, improving your vision.

The surgeon removes the clouded lens during cataract surgery and replaces it with a new artificial lens. Because the natural lens is removed, there is no possibility of developing another cataract in the future.

Safety changes mean that we are now able to treat **both eyes on the same day in most patients**. If you need or choose to have your eyes treated on different days, the worst eye will be treated first and the other eye treated subsequently.



ABOUT THE SURGERY – MANUAL CATARACT SURGERY

The surgery is usually carried out using local anaesthetic eye drops and takes around 10-20 minutes.

During the surgery, a tiny keyhole incision (2mm) is made into the cornea of the eye and the cloudy natural lens is removed with a highly sophisticated ultrasound probe.

The capsule of the lens is left behind and this is used to hold in place the new artificial lens implant.

Recovery is very quick and you will be able to see within a few minutes of the procedure. Your vision then progressively improves over the next few days.

FEMTOSECOND LASER CATARACT SURGERY

The laser automates some of the steps in the manual surgery process.

During the surgery, a laser is programmed to make a precise incision in your cornea and lens. This laser will break up the cloudy lens, which reduces the energy needed by the ultrasound probe to remove the lens.

The new artificial lens will then be implanted into the lens capsule. Low levels of astigmatism can also be treated by the laser at the time of surgery using the laser to gently reshape your cornea (front surface of the eye). Again, **recovery is very quick with this procedure**.

LASER FINE TUNING AFTER CATARACT SURGERY

Laser eye surgery allows further enhancement of the outcome of cataract surgery where there may be a small residual glasses prescription (1-2% of cases). **Laser enhancement is available to all cataract surgery patients at OCL Vision.**





What do I need to do to PREPARE FOR TREATMENT?

You will need to:

- **Sign your consent form electronically** on the surgery pack you will have received from DocuSign when you book your surgery, as well as your aftercare explanation.
- **Bring sunglasses** - they will help keep your eyes comfortable on the way home.
- **Not wear eye make up** on the day of treatment.
- **Remove contact lenses** for three days prior to surgery.
- **Organise getting home afterwards.** At OCL Vision we offer a comprehensive concierge service to cater for your transportation and accommodation needs.

What happens on THE SURGERY DAY?

- You will be at the clinic for up to **three hours**.
- The nurses will **prepare** you for surgery. They will use drops and a pellet to dilate your pupil(s) and **discuss the aftercare** with you.
- You will meet your surgeon again before surgery, who will explain **what to expect** during the surgery and answer any questions.
- Your eyes may feel tired or gritty for the rest of the day so we advise that you **go home and rest**.
- Vision is functional but not fully focused for the first **12-24 hours after surgery**.
- We will give you clear **eye shields** to wear at night after surgery to protect your eyes while you sleep.


* If your eyes feel sticky, they can be bathed with cooled boiled water using cotton pads.

Self-Pay Patients


For self-pay patients we accept all major debit and credit cards including AMEX (no additional fees) or BACS transfer.

We are partnered with Novuna and offer interest free finance, up to 24 months for all of our eye surgery procedures. Our affordable payment plans can make it easier to spread the cost of surgery over up to 60 months. Our payment plans cannot be used in conjunction with insurance or discounts and are subject to a credit check.

Insured Patients

We are registered with most major insurance companies and aim to bill within the cover the insurance companies provide. There are certain technologies we offer that insurance companies do not cover e.g. multifocal lenses - in these cases, there may be an excess to pay.



20/20 VISION CHART EXPLANATION

The 20/20 vision chart helps assess your visual acuity, measuring how clearly you can see letters or symbols from a distance of 20 feet.

If your vision is 20/20, you see what someone with normal vision sees at 20 feet. But if it's 20/40, you need to be 20 feet away to see what others see at 40 feet.

The chart has rows of decreasingly sized letters or symbols. Some people have sharper vision than 20/20, like 20/15 or even 20/10, achievable with modern vision correction techniques like laser eye surgery. For instance, if someone has 20/15 vision, they can see at 20 feet what a person with normal vision would need to be at 15 feet to see clearly.

At OCL Vision, we're here to discuss your options and guide you towards superior vision. Most of our patients experience better vision than they used to before with glasses or contacts.
