IMPLANTABLE COLLAMER LENS

Following your detailed consultation and specialist tests with us at OCL Vision, we are delighted to confirm that you are suitable for Implantable Collamer Lens (ICL) surgery.

ICL is a truly transformative procedure, offering freedom from glasses and contact lenses for those with higher prescriptions or who may not be candidates for laser vision correction. ICL surgery was first performed in 1993 with over 3 million ICLs implanted over the last 30+ years. This advanced treatment involves placing a tiny, biocompatible lens inside the eye to correct vision without permanently altering the cornea or natural lens.



One of the standout benefits of ICL is its reversibility. The ICL cannot be felt or seen once implanted inside the eye.

ICL is minimally invasive, reversible, and designed to correct a wide range of prescriptions, including severe myopia or astigmatism. The procedure offers rapid recovery times, and its long-term safety and effectiveness are supported by extensive clinical studies over 30 years. Laser eye surgery can be performed on top of an ICL if one's prescription were to change over the decades or as an enhancement of the outcome if there is any residual prescription.

About the SURGERY

EVO ICL™ surgery is an advanced vision correction procedure that uses a small, biocompatible lens to correct a wide range of refractive errors.

The EVO ICL™ lens made by Staar Surgical (USA) is designed to work with the eye's natural structures, offering clear, high-definition vision while leaving the cornea unchanged.

During the procedure, the surgeon creates a tiny, less than 3mm entry, through which the EVO ICL™ lens is gently inserted and positioned behind the pupil, in front of the natural lens. The incision is so small that it heals naturally without the need for stitches. This minimally invasive approach preserves the integrity of the cornea and avoids the complications associated with corneal reshaping, such as dry eye.

EVO ICL™ is suitable for treating myopia, hyperopia, and

astigmatism. The lens provides a precise and effective correction, improving visual clarity with long-lasting results. **The procedure is quick, typically taking around 20–30 minutes for both eyes**, and patients often experience rapid visual recovery with minimal discomfort.

One of the key benefits of EVO ICL™ is that it is a reversible procedure, allowing flexibility for future advancements in eye care and natural aging changes. **It's a safe, effective, and reliable option for patients seeking a life free from glasses and contact lenses**, with minimal disruption to the natural anatomy of the eye.



What do I need to do to PREPARE FOR TREATMENT?

You will need to:

- Sign your consent form:** This can be completed electronically via the surgery pack sent to you through DocuSign at the time of booking. It also includes an explanation of your aftercare plan.
- Bring sunglasses:** These will help protect your eyes and keep them comfortable on your journey home.
- Avoid eye makeup:** Do not wear any eye makeup on the day of your treatment.

What happens on THE SURGERY DAY?

- The procedure:** The surgery itself is carried out in the lens suite and typically takes around 20 minutes for both eyes.
- Arrival and consent:** Upon your arrival, we will welcome you to the clinic and confirm that you have signed the consent form.
- Pre-surgery consultation:** You will have a consultation before the procedure, during which your surgeon will answer any questions you may have.
- Aftercare discussion:** A nurse will guide you through the aftercare process, explaining how to care for your eyes immediately after surgery and in the days that follow. You will receive your aftercare drops, along with clear instructions on their usage to promote optimal recovery and healing. Additionally, we will inform you about your two main **follow-up appointments**, which are already scheduled for **2 weeks after surgery**. Should you feel the need for additional follow-ups, you are welcome to book them at no extra cost for up to one year after your procedure.
- Surgeon's check:** Your surgeon may examine your eyes prior to the procedure to ensure everything is in order.



Considering Implantable Collamer Lens surgery?

SHOWER/WASH HAIR

Do not wet your eyes directly for 1 week

Do not drive until your vision has cleared

Wear goggles for 4 weeks

Wear your eye shields at night



5 days

MAKE-UP

Do not wear eye make-up



3 days

CONTACT LENSES

Remove contact lenses.
Take surgeon's advice

Full exercise 2 weeks after treatment

Take advice from your surgeon



20/20 VISION CHART EXPLANATION

The 20/20 vision chart helps assess your visual acuity, measuring how clearly you can see letters or symbols from a distance of 20 feet.

If your vision is 20/20, you see what someone with normal vision sees at 20 feet. But if it's 20/40, you need to be 20 feet away to see what others see at 40 feet.

The chart has rows of decreasingly sized letters or symbols. Some people have sharper vision than 20/20, like 20/15 or even 20/10, achievable with modern vision correction techniques like laser eye surgery. For instance, if someone has 20/15 vision, they can see at 20 feet what a person with normal vision would need to be at 15 feet to see clearly.
